

connectFirst STEM Scholarship



The purpose of the STEM Scholarship is to help provide financial aid for students enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning for Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math field (STEM), and skilled trades programs in Alberta.

A total of four (4) scholarships worth \$500 each will be awarded each year.

To be eligible, applicants:

- Must be an Albertan resident between the ages of 17 and 25.
- Must be a current member of connectFirst Credit Union.
- Must be enrolled or accepted to enroll in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math field or a skilled trades program in Alberta.
- Must be a full-time student enrolled or accepted to enroll in an undergraduate or technical program in 2022.

Key dates:

- Application period from **June 15 to August 30, 2022.**
- Scholarship funds for awarded participants awarded no later than **October 31, 2022.**

How to apply:

Submit the following documentation:

- Application form
- Supporting documents:
 - Proof of enrolment
 - Proof of Alberta residency
 - Resume
 - Reference letter
 - Photo

Selection process:

- All STEM Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of connectFirst employees from September 15 to September 29.
- Successful applicants are notified by phone or email by September 30.
- Scholarship funds will be disbursed no later than October 31.
