

connectFirst STEM Scholarship



The purpose of the STEM Scholarship is to help provide financial aid for students enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning for Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math field (STEM), and skilled trades programs in Alberta.

A total of four (4) scholarships worth \$650 each will be awarded each year.

To be eligible, applicants:

- Must reside in Alberta and be age 17+ .
- Must be a current member of connectFirst Credit Union.
- Must be enrolled or accepted to enroll in an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Math field or a skilled trades program in Alberta.
- Must be a full-time student enrolled or accepted to enroll in an undergraduate or technical program in the academic year of 2023-2024.

Key dates:

- Application period from **July 25 to August 21, 2023.**
- Scholarship funds for awarded participants awarded no later than **September 11, 2023.**

How to apply:

Submit the following documentation to your preferred connectFirst Branch:

- Application form
- Supporting documents:
 - Proof of enrolment
 - Applicants must be residents of Alberta and be able to provide a home address, located in Alberta on the application form

Selection process:

- All STEM Scholarship applications will be reviewed by a committee comprised of connectFirst employees from **August 21 to September 1.**
- Successful applicants are notified by phone or email by **September 4.**
- Scholarship funds will be disbursed no later than **September 11.**
