Lack of examples or details were given.</p> <p>(0-4 marks)</p>
Savings Goal <i>Total 10 marks</i>	<p>You describe in detail how you are planning to save money and your answer clearly showcases</p>	<p>You state your intentions to save and provide a plan of action, but it's not fully fleshed out or detailed.</p>	<p>You state your intentions to save but do not have a clear plan of action.</p>	<p>You have not provided a clear intent to save nor an action plan to save successfully</p>

<p>Mentorship Goals</p> <p>Total 10 marks</p>	<p>You describe in detail what skills and knowledge you'd like to learn from your mentor, demonstrating clear thought and reflection. You share <i>why</i> you want to learn certain skills, enhancing your answer.</p> <p>You identify a few skills and provide a clear idea of what your learning goals are.</p> <p>(9-10 marks)</p>	<p>You share and state your learning goals, while identifying a few specific skills that you'd like to learn from your mentor, but you do not expand or provide additional details such as the <i>why</i> behind your goals.</p> <p>Solid answer with an indication on what you're hoping to learn.</p> <p>(7-8 marks)</p>	<p>You share and state general learning goals, but do not identify specific skills.</p> <p>Your answer could have been expanded on to clearly showcase your learning plan/desires.</p> <p>(5-6 marks)</p>	<p>You have not provided a clear answer on what skills you are hoping to learn. You provide a general statement that you're eager to learn but do not identify what that looks like.</p> <p>(0-4 marks)</p>
<p>Spelling & Grammar</p> <p>Total 5 marks</p>	<p>Understandable sentence structure, limited spelling, or grammar errors.</p> <p>(5 marks)</p>	<p>Mostly understandable sentence structure, a few spelling or grammar errors found.</p> <p>(4 marks)</p>	<p>Sentences can sometimes be hard to understand, and there were a lot of spelling or grammar errors.</p> <p>(2-3 marks)</p>	<p>Essay answers were difficult to read to the numerous spelling, grammar and structure errors.</p> <p>(0-1 marks)</p>
<p>Word Count</p> <p>Total 5 marks</p>	<p>All essay answers met the word count limit of 150 words or less and did not go over the MAX limit of 180 words.</p> <p>(5 marks)</p>	<p>Most essay answers met the word count limit of 150 words or less, but some went over the MAX limit of 180 words.</p> <p>(4 marks)</p>	<p>Most essay answers did not meet the word count of 150 words or less, or most of them went over the MAX limit of 180 words.</p> <p>(2-3 marks)</p>	<p>ALL essay answers did not meet the word count of 150 words, or all essay answers went over the MAX limit of 180 words.</p> <p>(0-1 marks)</p>
